Joseph G. Paciulli Elected Chairman of the Loudoun County Economic Development Commission

Fairfax, Virginia — At their January meeting, the Loudoun County Economic Development Commission (EDC) elected Joseph G. Paciulli for a second term as chairman for 2006.

Over this past year, Joe has guided the Commission as it strongly supported the extension of rail to Loudoun, reviewed advanced higher education opportunities and achieved funding for increased international business opportunities. For 2006, the EDC will focus on advancing Loudoun County as a superior business location and will study the County's corridors for opportunities to advance economic development.

Established in 1995 by Loudoun County's Board of Supervisors, the EDC is a public/private partnership responsible for promoting Loudoun's economic development. The EDC serves as a forum through which business and government leaders meet to exchange ideas and experiences about business growth in the county. It is organized with twenty-seven voting members, featuring representatives from diverse industries such as: aerospace, agribusiness, banking & engineering, finance, higher education, manufacturing, professional services, real estate development, retail, small business and telecommunications.
