**Worldwide Department of Defense Awards
First Army Contractor Position to
Armed Forces Pest Management Board (AFPMB)**

Steve Watters, a Paciulli, Simmons & Associates Ft. Belvoir site employee, was recently selected to serve as a voting member on the Armed Forces Pest Management Board (AFPMB). This Board sets policy, reviews new technology, and provides precedence and guidance for all pest management actions within the Department of Defense worldwide. Steve is the *first* Army contractor to be invited, nominated and honored for this position.

Since September 2000, Steve has held the position of Integrated Pest Management Facilitator at Fort Belvoir. During this period, he has been responsible for providing methods of applying the least toxic pesticides, ensuring chemicals are applied as a last resort, and tracking pesticide usage on Fort Belvoir by contractors, Army and Air Force Exchange Services (AAFES) and the Commissary. Steve has also contributed to writing the Integrated Pest Management Plan for Fort Belvoir and has acted as the liaison between AAFES, Commissary, and Environmental personnel in handling pest problems as well as the liaison between Golf Course and Environmental personnel in correcting pest and animal problems negatively affecting the Golf Course.
